Electronic Sources (Library Databases) – Citations to Journal Articles and/or Books

Academic OneFile (formerly *InfoTrac OneFile*) 1980+

Provides citations, abstracts, and some full text articles from journals with good coverage of the social sciences and a wide variety of health and medical topics.

Academic Search Premier

Premier

A full-text, multidisciplinary magazine & journal database that provides the full text of over 4,500 journals and magazines, and indexes a total of more than 8,000 titles in all disciplines.

AGELINE 1978+

Summarizes articles in social gerontology (the study of aging in psychological, health-related, social, and economic contexts).

Child Abuse, Child Welfare & Adoption 1965+

References to books, journal articles, final reports from federally-funded grants, conference papers, unpublished papers, reports on completed or continuing research. Also includes descriptions of service programs and prevention and treatment strategies.

Current Awareness Service

Many of the libraries' licensed research databases and electronic journal collections offer users the ability to create research alert profiles — automated keyword and tables of content searches — sent weekly to an email address.

ERIC 1966+

Key education database of citations, abstracts from education journals (EJ), education documents/reports (ED), and full text digests.

LexisNexis News

Full text for most materials, including newspapers, magazines, news wires, transcripts, and legal resources. Good coverage of international news, but includes only a few academic research journals.

LGBT Life with Full Text

GLBT Life is the premier resource to the world's literature regarding Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual and Transgender issues. This database contains indexing and abstracts for more than 80 GLBT-specific core periodicals.

POPLINE pre-1983+

An international index to journal articles, books, technical reports and unpublished works on population, family planning and related health care, law and policy issues. Some items date back to 1827.

PsycINFO 1887+

References to and summaries of the key journal articles in the international psychology and behavioral science literature and the related fields of education, business, medicine, and law. Starting with 1987, also includes books and book chapters.

PubMed – MEDLINE through *National Library of Medicine* 1966+

Medline is the National Library of Medicine's (NLM) premier database of journal citations and abstracts covering nearly 4,500 journals published in the U.S. and more than 70 other countries. In addition to providing access to MEDLINE, PubMed provides access to out-of-scope citations from certain MEDLINE journals, primarily general science and chemistry journals for which the life sciences articles are indexed for MEDLINE; citations that precede the date that a journal was selected for MEDLINE indexing; and some additional life science journals that submit full text to PubMedCentral™ and receive a qualitative review by NLM.

SCOPUS 1966+

SCOPUS is the world's largest journal indexing and abstracting database with 27 million records covering articles from 14,000 peer-reviewed titles from more than 4,000 international publishers. It is the most comprehensive scientific, medical, technical and social science point of access containing all relevant literature.

Social Sciences Citation Index 1987, 1989-1999

Babbidge Library, Level 1, Information Café 2, Table 6 / SSCI Workstation

References to articles in over 1,400 social science journals and selected articles from 4,500 related journals. Features citation and related reference searching. See also *Web of Science* below.

Sociological Abstracts 1963+

International in scope, many foreign language journals are included.

Web of Science 1994+

Offers citation searching for the sciences, social sciences, and humanities (including **Science Citation Index, Social Sciences Citation Index, and Arts & Humanities Citation Index**) on authors, co-authors, and keyword searching of abstracts and titles.
